

For Federal Payments:

The IRS has changed the payment due date to July 15th but has not provided any guidance as to whether or not they will be debiting the payments that you authorized for withdrawal on April 15th. You have three choices on how to address this –

- We still have three weeks, so we can wait at least 10 days, and see if they give us specific guidance as to whether the April 15th payments will instead be withdrawn on July 15th.
- The second choice is to call the IRS and the state to request the cancellation of your payment. We have shared instructions for that below.
- The third choice is to just leave things as they are, and take the risk that the money will be withdrawn on April 15.

If you want to cancel your payment, you need to call 1-888-353-4537. You will need the exact amount that you owe and the bank account number that you're having the money withdrawn from. You then must remember to pay your taxes by July 15th to avoid penalties and interest. You can pay on-line at www.irs.gov or we can send you a voucher.

Please note: If you decide to cancel a pre-instructed payment you can make your payment online. The various state websites are listed below. You may need to create an online account with the various tax departments to make these payments. A second option is to contact our office to obtain a voucher to mail in with your payment.
